Bacon Construction has said they will need two more weeks to finish the project. I have been assured that it will ONLY BE TWO WEEKS. I explained that I am willing to break the bad news of the delay ONCE, but they cannot come back and asked for more time. I have been assured that it won't happen.

The attached letter explains the reasons for the delay. So three things:

- 1. The elementary school will be delayed two weeks (8 school days) with a new start date of 9/15 for grades 1-4, 9/15 for kindergarten, and 9/19 for preschool. (All of these dates are two weeks later. I will be requesting a waiver for 4 of the 8 days.
- 2. The middle school, high school and Gardner Academy will only be starting one week late (9/6).
