State-of-the-Art Outdoor Fitness Court[®] Coming to Gardner High School

The Fitness Court[®] is the world's best outdoor gym that lets people use their own body weight to get a complete workout using seven exercise stations.

Created with people aged 14 and over, and with all abilities in mind, the workouts are adaptable for all fitness levels, allowing participants to move at their own pace. Users also may download the free <u>Fitness Court App</u> which acts as a coach-in-your-pocket and enhances the outdoor gym into a digitally supported wellness experience.

Gardner is one of 15 outdoor Fitness Courts[®] in a series of Blue Cross Fitness Courts that will be constructed in easily accessible public spaces throughout 2022-2023. Over the next five years, Blue Cross will provide \$16 million in grants and volunteer support to not-for-profits working to address food, environmental and racial justice in Massachusetts communities.
