MassDEP regulations (310 CMR 22.15(8)) require that all public water systems establishing mandatory restrictions on water use notify the Department in writing within 14 days of the effective date of these restrictions. This notice must include a description of the appropriate regulations, bylaws or ordinances imposing the restriction. Proper completion and submission of this form may serve as that notification. MassDEP also requests that systems implementing a voluntary water use restriction, or amending or ending a restriction, complete and submit this form.
