COOKING/CAMP FIRE POLICY

Cooking/Camp Fires are permitted subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Residents should call the Fire Department at 978-630-4051 before having a Cooking/Camp fire. Fires may be prohibited due to weather conditions.
- 2. Fires must be attended at all times by a person 18 years of age or older.
- 3. Fires must be contained in a fireplace or fire pit surrounded by rocks, bricks, cinder blocks, or similar noncombustible material. Fire pits are limited to 3' in diameter.
- 4. Commercially available fireplaces or chimeneas are allowed provided they are on the ground or other noncombustible surface. They are prohibited on decks/porches.
- 5. Fires must be kept small (no more than 3' high) and not create a smoke nuisance.
- 6. Fires must be a minimum of 15' from any combustible structure (including buildings, decks, sheds, fences, etc.)
- 7. Fires must be fueled by natural, chemical-free wood. Trash, rubbish, and construction debris are prohibited. No full pallets.
- 8. A water source to extinguish the fire must be available in the immediate vicinity.
- 9. Fires must be completely extinguished when finished.

The Fire Department can order any fire extinguished that does not meet these conditions, or is determined to be a hazard or nuisance.

Remember, a Cooking/Camp Fire is **NOT** a bon fire.
