The Board of Assessors held a meeting on Tuesday where they reviewed the Tax Rate Recap; the Board signed and submitted it in DLS Gateway Tuesday afternoon. The State now has to review and approve it before a FY'2026 tax rate is set. Additional follow up work was done after the meeting. A reminder that annual Chapterland applications for 61A and 61B properties are due 12/01/2025. Update from last week: Commitment #6 for 2025 from the RMV was released and processed by our office.

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DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

DIRECTOR: I'd like to take a moment to thank everyone for their patience with my medical leave and the continuing follow up appointments and physical therapy.

COMMUNICABLE DISEASES: MDPH has brought to our attention an increase in Mpox cases reported in 2025; since October there have been 34 cases, 20 of which occurred between August 1 and October 1. To date none have been reported in the immediate area.

BOARD OF HEALTH: The next Board of Health meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, 12/2/25 @ 7:00 PM.

CONSERVATION COMMISSION: Templeton remains in a Level 2 Significant Drought/Level 1 Mild Drought. COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE: Grant Award Agreements are continuing to be signed by the appropriate parties. The next CPC meeting is scheduled for 12/11/25 @ 7:00 PM with a Needs Analysis meeting to be held on 1/8/26 @ 6:00 PM.

PLANNING BOARD: Due to lack of agenda items, the Planning Board meeting scheduled for November 26, 2025, has been cancelled; the next meeting is scheduled for December 9, 2025, at 6:30 pm.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: Nothing to report.

AGRICULTURAL COMMISSION: The next AgCom meeting is scheduled for Monday, 12/1/25 @ 6:00 PM.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT: Five building permits, five electrical permits, two plumbing permits and two gas fitting permits were processed this week. Fourteen inspections have been completed for liquor serving establishments; certificates will be distributed in time for 2026 license renewals. Commissioner Hanks performed multiple inspections this week and three permits were closed with certificates of completion issued. Admin submitted four turnovers, one warrant and inspector payroll to Accounting and responded to inquiries regarding zoning, permitting, ADU rules; and Board of Health concerns including, chickens trespassing, excessive trash and debris, annual food permits and sewerage haulers licensing.
